Pharmaceutical and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee

The Pharmaceutical and Therapeutics (P&T) Committee has been established by the Division of Medicaid and Medical Assistance (DMMA) to provide clinical leadership in the selection of preferred medications. This selection will be based on a review of the relative clinical effectiveness and cost of products within selected therapeutic classes. The program's objective is to achieve quality pharmaceutical care for recipients enrolled in the Department's Medicaid programs while providing significant state savings.
